AMENDMENT TO STIPULATED AGREEMENT

Come now the Signatories to the Stipulated Agreement (“Stipulation”) filed herein on November 24, 2004 and the Coalition for Clean Affordable Energy (“CCAIE”) and stipulate as follows:

1. By executing this Amendment, CCAIE joins in and becomes a Signatory to the Stipulation, as amended herein.
2. ¶ C.1.(b) of the Stipulation is amended to read as follows (additions underlined; deletions crossed out):

“PNM will install approximately ~~5025~~ kW of solar PV panels at the single generation site in a) above at a cost of \$~~5~~300,000 or less.”

3. ¶ C.1.(g) of the Stipulation is deleted and the following provision is substituted as ¶ C.1.(g):

“Provided that PNM files with the Commission following the conclusion of the 2005 Legislative session, but no later than August 1, 2005, a list of specific expenditures to develop a customer owned PV program that has been agreed upon by the Signatories, PNM will expend up to \$200,000 in 2005 on the listed expenditures.”

4. Except as modified herein, the Stipulation remains in full force and effect.

5. Agreement to the terms of this Amendment may be indicated by the execution of a separate signature page.


